## Fingerprint Processing of Difficult Surfaces Workshop

This is a hands-on workshop that will demonstrate various techniques used to obtain fingerprint evidence from difficult surfaces. This is a class for individuals who have had previous training on processing for latent prints and who want to improve their skills. Demonstrations will be given on using various brands of fingerprint powders, tapes and brushes and how to determine if your lifting material or powders are old or ineffective. Novel lifting and preservation methods will be discussed plus Pentel rol n glue, Microsil and Accutrans. Magnetic fingerprint powders will be described and how to develop latent prints on wet papers. Two new techniques for development of latent prints on latex or vinyl gloves will also be demonstrated. This workshop will give participants practical knowledge that can be used in the field, plus a workshop booklet will be included. Those who attend will be able to contact the instructor for any questions that may develop from the demonstrated techniques.
